RE: History of Energy Savings

A <u>12 month</u> history of energy savings for Summersville Presbyterian Church <u>March 1, 2010 to February 28, 2011</u>.

This <u>8500 Square Ft.</u> Edifice, heated with a 7 year old <u>"Smith" 700,000 BTU</u>, <u>17.5 HP</u> cast iron boiler using <u>428.3 thousand cubic feet</u> of natural gas during the period.

The line was equipped with <u>three #848 GMX magnetic units</u> on <u>March 1, 2010</u> near the "in feed" on code approved <u>stainless steel flexible "gastite"</u>.

The results were <u>95.600 cubic feet less</u> gas consumed than during the previous 12 month period. Resulting <u>in gas savings of 16.5%</u> and a **dollar savings of \$810.00** or **18.4%**.

The numbers are confirmed by comparing monthly invoices/meter readings by Columbia Gas, together with heating degree days from National Weather Service.
